

In the Catholic Church, Epiphany is a feast day that celebrates the manifestation of Jesus as the Messiah and the arrival of the Magi to visit the baby Jesus:

Date

Epiphany is celebrated on January 6, also known as Three Kings' Day.

Significance

The feast commemorates the Magi, or the Three Kings, who traveled from the East to Bethlehem, led by a star. The Magi are the first Gentile witnesses to Jesus' message of salvation.

Traditions

Some traditions associated with Epiphany include:

Blessing the home:

A pastor or family member may bless the home with holy water and a prayer.

Chalking the doors: A centuries-old tradition of inscribing letters between the numbers of the year on doors. The letters refer to the names of the Magi, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar.
